A Bachelor of Public Health graduate with a proven record in community development and sustainable sanitation, having led an STBM program that increased ODF progress by **50% across five villages** and guided **58 villages to Open Defecation Free (ODF) status**, contributing to a **25% reduction in diarrhoea cases** and **90% program compliance**. Skilled in field data collection and validation, team training and mentoring, and participatory approaches involving **150+ community health workers** and hundreds of community members.
